MINUTES OF BUSINESS SESSION

The Chairman opened the floor for discussion and resolution of proposed agenda as follows:

AGENDA & RESOLUTIONS OF THE MCTA CONFERENCE 2010

(GROUP A)

MATTERS CONCERNING GOVERNMENT OF MIZORAM

1. The Government of Mizoram be pressurized to fill up all vacant posts of Lecturers in colleges with immediate effect. (CTE)./GOM be moved to fill up all the vacant posts in all the colleges with regular posts before the introduction of Semester system in June 2011 (Govt. Saiha College).

The Chairman invited the concerned Branches to move the agenda. After the submitting Branch moved the agenda, the Chairman opened the floor for further discussions. After discussions, it was decided that 'the Government of Mizoram be pressurized to fill up all vacant posts of Lecturers in colleges'

2. The Government of Mizoram be requested to appoint a separate lecturer for environmental studies in the college in Mizoram. (Govt Johnson College).

The Chairman requested the concerned Branch to move the agenda and it was resolved that 'the Government of Mizoram be requested to appoint a separate lecturer for environmental studies in the colleges in Mizoram'.

3. The Government of Mizoram be requested to strengthen the non-teaching staff in every college to cater to the semester system of examination from 2011. (Govt. Johnson College).

After the Chairman invited the submitting Branch to move the agenda, it was resolved without discussion that 'the Government of Mizoram be requested to

strengthen the non-teaching staff in every college to cater to the semester system of examination from 2011'.

4. The Government of Mizoram be effectively pressurised to adopt UGC Pay as a composite scheme. (Govt J.Thankima College)/The GOM be pressurised to implement the superannuation age of lecturers as per UGC 6th pay recommendation. (Govt. T.Romana College)

The agenda was presented by the concerned Branch on the invitation of the Chairman and was discussed thoroughly. After long deliberation of the agenda 'the Government of Mizoram be effectively pressurised to adopt UGC Pay as a composite scheme including superannuation age' is passed unanimously.

MATTERS CONCERNING MIZORAM UNIVESITY

5. MZU be pressurized to conduct all end semester examinations and further be requested the august meeting to approve resolution passed by the Executive Committee meeting in this regard. (MCTA Hqrs)

After the General Secretary of MCTA Hqrs moved the agenda, it was decided without much discussion that 'MZU be pressurized to conduct all end semester examinations and further be requested the august meeting to approve resolution passed by the Executive Committee meeting in this regard'.

6. MZU be pressed to prepare common question for the first 4 semesters. (Govt Hnahthial College)

After the Chairman explained the matter it was resolved that 'the MZU be pressed to prepare common question for the first 4 semesters'.

7. MZU Sport Board be pressed to take necessary measures to stop chaos and turmoil during MZU sport in future.(Hqrs)

The Chairman requested Dr. R.Zonuntluanga, Vice President, MCTA Hqrs to move the agenda and was followed by discussions. After due consideration of the issue, it was resolved with some modifications that 'the MZU Sport Board be pressed to take necessary measures for peaceful conduct of MZU sport in future'.

MATTERS CONCERNING MCTA HQRS

Let the MCTA Hqrs prepare a model code for the better attendance of MCTA members in the conference. (Govt T.Romana College)

After the submitting Branch presented the agenda on the invitation of the Chairman, it was decided that 'let the MCTA Hqrs prepare a model code for the better attendance of MCTA members in the conference'.

(Group B)

1. Let the MCTA Headquarters exert more effort towards building a Guest House for Mizoram College Teachers in Aizawl. (Govt Mamit College)

The Chairman informed the meeting about the Executive Committee's view on the matter. The meeting accepts the on-going pressure of the Executive Committee with due consideration of financial constraints.

2. The Directorate of Higher & Technical Education be requested to be vigilant about the ACRs of the college teachers. (Govt Johnson College)

The Chairman informed the meeting about the activities taken up by the Executive Committee towards the agenda. It is said that the matter is brought to the notice of the concerned authorities and favorable action is expected.

3. Let the GOM clarify its stand expeditiously whether to fully implement the UGC regulations or formulate its own recruitment and service rule expediting the process of framing the said rules in the latter case. (Lunglei Govt College)

The Chairman explained that the matter is an on-going activity of the Executive Committee.

4. Let the MCTA Hqrs convene a special meeting to brief all college lecturers regarding the implementation of the semester system in colleges. (Govt Aizawl North College)

The Chairman explained that since the MZU itself has not clarified the issue no further action could be taken in this regard.

5. Let the minutes of the MCTA Annual General Conference be made ready for distribution to all members on the following day of the conference. (Lunglei Govt College)

The Chairman explained that the matter is not possible at the present situation. Members will be given the Conference Minute as soon as possible.

6. Let the total collection of the conference fund minus conference related official expenses be given to the conference hosting Branch. (Lunglei Govt College)

After the submitting Branch gives some explanation on the matter, the Chairman also explained the issue. It was decided to maintain the status quo.

7. UGC be pressed for release of 80% arrear. (Govt Hnahthial College)

The Chairman informed the meeting that the matter is an on-going activity of the Headquarters.

8. Let the Mizoram University be pressurised to take up the responsibility of conducting the ent semester examination, allotting 25% marks for internal (continuous) assessment. (Lunglei Govt College)

The Chairman informed the meeting that this is related to the earlier agenda (Agenda No. 5) which was already resolved.

9. The GOM be pressurised to give importance and acknowledgement of the status of lecturers as Gr A officers regarding their rights to accommodation and utilisation in the Mizoram houses in and outside the state. (Govt T.Romana College)

The Chairman informed the meeting that this is also an on-going programme of the Headquarters.

10. The GOM be moved to implement the 6th UGC Pay within November 2010 according to UGC norms (Govt Saiha College)

The Chairman explained that this is an on-going activity of the Headquarters and is related to the earlier agenda (No.4). No separate resolution is considered necessary.

11. The GOM be pressurized to release the 6th UGC Pay arrear (ie, 1.1.2006-31.3.2010) as early as possible. (Govt Saiha College)

The Chairman informed the meeting that the matter is also an on-going activity of the Headquarters.

12. The GOM be pressurized to place all the colleges in Mizoram as University colleges. (Govt Saiha College)

The Chairman clarified that the GOM can not be pressed in this regard and this is the purview of the Central Government.

13. Let the MCTA clarify the status of attached lecturers in relation to the College/Branch they are attached. (Govt Hrangbana College)

The Chairman informed the meeting about the resolution of the Executive Committee in this regard that the attached lecturers be considered as full member of the MCTA in the college in which they are attached.
