**Welcome Speech :**

The First Session of the 33<sup>rd</sup> General Conference commenced with welcome speech delivered by the Vice President, Dr. R.Zonuntluanga. In his speech Dr. R.Zonuntluanga pointed out the special significance of the Conference as new MCTA Hqrs Office Bearers will be elected for the year 2011 – 2013. He further requested the delegates coming from different parts of the State to actively participate in the proceedings of the Conference. The Vice President also apologized for not having a Chief Guest for the occasion and mentioned that the Executive Committee had invited some high dignitaries to be the Chief Guest, but due to prior engagement with other programmes they could not spare their time.

**President's Address :**

The welcome speech was followed by Presidential address. In his Presidential speech, Pu Ramhmangaiha Ralte, President of MCTA Hqrs. urged members to stand united in promoting the interest of the teaching community and in improving the quality of higher education. The President also requested the coming newly elected Office Bearers to uphold ethics of integrity, unity, harmony and hard work. The President thanked all members of MCTA for the support rendered by them throughout his term as President of MCTA.

**MINUTES OF BUSINESS SESSION**  
**(12:15 p.m - 2:30 p.m)**

The MCTA President Pu Ramhmangaiha Ralte presided over the business session and requested members to raise any queries regarding the General Secretary's report and Statement of Account presented in the first session. After making clarification for a number of queries raised by the delegates the Chairman opened the floor for discussion and resolutions of proposed agenda were made as follows:

**AGENDA & RESOLUTIONS**

**(GROUP A)**

**MATTERS CONCERNING GOVERNMENT OF MIZORAM**

**1. The Government of Mizoram be pressurized to release Sixth Pay Arrear before Christmas. (Gov't Serchhip College)**

**Release of Pay Arrear by the State Government before December 2011. (Gov't Johnson College)**

**The Government of Mizoram be strongly pressurized to release the pending arrears in connection with UGC 6<sup>th</sup> Pay. (Gov't T.Romana College)**

*The Chairman invited the concerned Branches to move the agenda. After the agenda was moved, the Chairman opened the floor for further discussions and it was resolved that 'the Government of Mizoram be pressurized to release the pending arrears in connection with the implementation of the 6<sup>th</sup> UGC Pay in Mizoram (i.e 1.1.2009 - 28.2.2011) before 15<sup>th</sup> December 2011'.*

*The meeting further resolved that if the government fails to release the pay arrears before 15<sup>th</sup> December 2011, college teachers will call a strike starting from 15<sup>th</sup> December and also refrain from attending the CM Programme.*

**2. Gov't of Mizoram be pressurised for the provincialization of Kamalanagar Deficit College (Kamalanagar College)**

*The Chairman explained the current situation and after discussion it was resolved that the Govt. of Mizoram be pressurized for the provincialisation of Kamalanagar deficit college .*

- 3. Gov't of Mizoram be pursued for the early disbursement of increased pay arrear (26% & 14%) and other arrears due to Kamalanagar College Staff. (Kamalanagar College)**

*After the Chairman invited the concerned Branch to move and clarified the agenda, it was resolved that the efforts made by the individual college authorities for the release of the said pay arrear be assisted as needed.*

- 4. The Gov't of Mizoram be pressurized to review or to modify the proforma of PBAS/API. (Gov't T.Romana College)**

*The agenda was presented by the concerned Branch on the invitation of the Chairman and the meeting resolved that the Govt. of Mizoram be pressurized to modify the proforma of PBAS/API.*

- 5. The Gov't of Mizoram be pressurized to allocate sufficient funds in Higher & Technical Education budget. (Gov't T.Romana College)**

*After the Chairman explained the agenda it was resolved that the Govt. be pressurized to allocate sufficient funds in the Higher & Technical Education Department budget.*

- 6. Gov't authorities be pressurized to constitute the Mizoram H&TE Service (MIHTES) as recommended by the Mizoram Education Reforms Commission (MERC) and Group of Experts (GOE). (Gov't J Thankima College)**

*The Chairman clarified and explained the nature of inclusion of the proposed agenda in the recommendation of the MERC and it was resolved without discussion to move the agenda under group B.*

### **MATTERS CONCERNING MCTA HQRS**

- 1. The MCTA Gen. Hqrs should take initiative to form a Federation of all Teachers, from Elementary Schools to Colleges under the Gov't of Mizoram. (Gov't Aizawl West College)**

*The agenda was presented by the concerned Branch on the invitation of the Chairman and after discussion the agenda was not passed.*

- 2. Inter Branch MCTA Sport be organized. (Gov't Johnson College)**

*The agenda was presented by the concerned Branch on the invitation of the Chairman and after discussion the agenda was dropped in view of the limited time for engagement in such activities.*

**3. Let the MCTA Hqrs. take up steps to have a Guest House for College Professors like that of the Teachers Inn in Aizawl. (Gov't Saiha College)**

*The Chairman invited the concerned branch to move the agenda and after the agenda was explained, discussion followed. The meeting resolved that the MCTA Hqrs should seek various means for having a Guest House in Aizawl for College Teachers*

**MATTERS CONCERNING MIZORAM UNIVESITY**

**1. MZU must provide at least 3 (three) sets of Questions in each Paper for moderation. (Gov't Zirtiri Res Science College)**

*After the concerned branch moved the agenda on the invitation of the Chairman, the meeting resolved that MZU be requested to provide at least 3 sets of Questions in each paper for moderation.*

**(Group B)**

**1. The Gov't of Mizoram be requested to fill up Principals' Post and other equivalent posts (Jt. Director, etc.) on the basis of seniority. (Gov't Saiha College)**

*The Chairman informed the meeting that since college teachers have used the new UGC Regulation 2010, the need for such separate proposition does not arise.*

**2. The Gov't of Mizoram be pressurised to allow the College authorities to supervise the construction of their respective college with the fund received from the DONER, GOI. (Gov't Aizawl North College)**

*The Chairman informed the meeting that this is the purview of the concerned college authorities.*

**3. The Gov't of Mizoram refused to upgrade teachers as per the UGC Regulations (2000) who have not completed their Refresher/Orientation Course before June 2010, resulted to many teachers not upgraded who could not complete their courses before June 2010.**

**Let MCTA take up the cause of these teachers and move the government to extent the date (March 31, 2011) of RC/OC and upgrade them respectively. (Gov't J.Buana College)**

*The Chairman explained that the matter is an on-going activity of the AIFUCTO to which the MCTA is affiliated.*

**4. Proper facilities be accorded to faculties for attending international seminar/conferences. (Gov't Zirtiri Res Science College)**

*The Chairman informed the meeting that since facilities accorded to faculties for attending such international seminar/conference are provided by the organizing institutions, the need for such proposal does not arise.*

**5. The Gov't of Mizoram be pressurised to implement retirement age of 65 years as recommended by the UGC Regulations 2010. (Gov't Aizawl West College)**

*The Chairman notified the meeting that the matter is an ongoing activity of the MCTA.*

**6. The Department of H&TE should repatriate all the non-teaching staff who have been appointed to various colleges, to the respective colleges where they were appointed. (Gov't Aizawl West College)**

*The chairman apprised that this is the purview of the administrative department.*

**7. MZU is to be pressurised to create reservation of seats for in-service applicants in research studies. (Gov't Serchhip College)**

*The Chairman informed the meeting that even without reservation of seats provisions are made to such applicants.*

**8. The Gov't of Mizoram be pressurised to pay FPA to college teachers as per admissible under Mizoram Gov't notification to its employees. (Gov't Serchhip College)**

*The Chairman informed the meeting that this is an ongoing activity of the MCTA Hqrs.*

The business session ended with vote of thanks from Pu Lalchangliana, Secretary i/c Organisation, MCTA Hqrs.
