MINUTES OF BUSINESS SESSION (01:30 p.m - 3:30 p.m)

Chairman : Pu Thanglura, President, MCTA Hqrs.

The business session was presided over by Pu Thanglura, President, MCTA Hqrs. The Chairman invited the members to actively participate in the business transaction.

General Secretary's Report:

On the invitation of Chairman, Dr. P.L.Ramlina, General Secretary gave detailed reports of the activities of the MCTA Hqrs during the year 2011-2012. He also introduced the Office Bearers of Hqrs. and Executive Members of the MCTA Hqrs. The general secretary's report prepared in booklet was distributed to the delegates.

The Chairman requested members to raise any queries on the General Secretary's report. After making clarification for a number of queries raised by the delegates, the report was approved by the floor. The Chairman then requested Pu H.Lalnunmawia, Treasurer, to place the Statement of Account, 2011-2012 before the meeting.

Finance Report :

Pu H.Lalnunmawia, Treasurer, MCTA Hqrs placed audited statement of accounts for the year 2011-2012 before the meeting. As per the report, the statement of account may be summed up as follows:

The Treasurer reported that as per a decision made by the MCTA Hqrs. Executive meeting held on 4th October, 2012, the Welfare Fund Account was closed and consequently discontinued. As such the balance of Rs. 44,071 is transferred to the General Fund Account. The Treasurer also informed the meeting that a new Saving Bank Account was opened at the SBI, Dawrpui Branch for convenient business transaction.

After making necessary clarification for a number of queries raised by the delegates, the floor approved the report.

The Chairman opened the floor for discussion and resolutions of proposed agenda were made as follows:

AGENDA & RESOLUTIONS

(GROUP A)

MATTERS CONCERNING GOVERNMENT OF MIZORAM

1. **The Government of Mizoram be pressurized to appoint regular principals and professors and give benefit as per UGC norms. (Gov't Aizawl College)**

The Government of Mizoram be pressurized to fill up principals and professors in various colleges of Mizoram, immediately as per UGC rules. (Gov't Johnson College)

The Government of Mizoram be pressurized to fill up all vacant principal's posts in the colleges by duly qualified regular principal at the earliest possible time. (Gov't Aizawl North College).

As the above agenda are similar in nature, the Chairman invited Govt. Johnson College and Govt. Aizawl College to move and clarify their agenda. After the

submitting Branches moved the agenda, the Chairman opened the floor for further discussion. It was therefore, resolved that "The Govt of Mizoram be pressurized to appoint regular principals and professors as per UGC rules and let the MCTA Hqrs pursue the matter"

- 2. The GoM be requested to constitute a team of professionals to study the courses and system of semester education in other Universities and give appropriate recommendations. ((Gov't Aizawl College)**

The Chairman invited the concerned Branch to move the agenda. After the agenda was moved, it was discussed and finally resolved that the matter should be brought before the appropriate authority.

- 3. The vacant posts of Associate Professor, Asst. Professor posts in Colleges be filled up immediately. (CTE/IASE)**

Let the MCTA leaders pressurize the State Government to fill up all vacant posts in different colleges. (Lunglei Gov't College)

The above agenda were clapped together and was discussed after making clarification by the submitting Branches. After deliberations the meeting resolved that "Let the MCTA leaders pressurize the State Government to fill up all vacant posts of Asst. Professor in all Colleges"

- 4. The total amount of fees collected by Colleges must be retained in view of paltry cash provisions accorded to colleges. (Govt. ZRSC)**

The Chairman invited the concerned Branch to move the agenda. After discussion the agenda was modified and resolved that "The Govt of Mizoram be requested to allot more funds for Colleges from fees collected by Colleges"

MATTER CONCERNING MCTA HQRS

- 1. Let the MCTA take steps to improve quality of higher education and teachers' accountability as per UGC norms. (Headquarters)**

The agenda was presented by General Secretary, MCTA Hqrs on the invitation of the Chairman and after discussion the agenda was passed as proposed.

(Group B) (On-going Activities)

- 1. The Gov't of Mizoram be requested to reconsider rationalisation policy of College Teachers. (Govt. Aizawl College)**

The Chairman informed the meeting that the Hqrs. had already submitted a representation regarding the opposition to the policy.

- 2. The Gov't of Mizoram be pressurized to give equal credits and benefits to College Teachers as is given to other government servants of equal status and ranks. (Gov't Aizawl College)**

The Chairman informed the meeting that realization of the matter is very difficult in view of the present situation.

- 3. The Gov't of Mizoram be pushed to disburse MR as earliest possible without delay. (Gov't Saitual College)**

The Chairman explained that the matter is an on-going activity of the Hqrs.

- 4. Higher & Technical rules be instituted at the earliest. (Lunglei Govt College)**

The Chairman informed the meeting that the matter is under consideration of the Government.

- 5. Regular appointment for existing teachers on contract basis. (Lunglei Govt College)**

The Chairman notified the meeting that the matter is an ongoing activity of the MCTA.

- 6. Let the MCTA Hqrs take initiative with the Directorate and Secretariat of H&TE for the safe keeping custody of the ACRs and PBAS/API submitted by College teachers. (Gov't Mamit College)**

The chairman apprised that the matter is already brought to the notice of the authority.

- 7. Govt. of Mizoram be pressurized for provincialisation of Kamalanagar Deficit College. (Kamalanagar College)**

The Chairman informed the meeting that the Government is taking necessary steps in this regard.

- 8. Enhancement of remuneration for teachers employed as 'regular part-time'.**

The Chairman informed the meeting that this could not be implemented due to financial constraint.

- 9. Let the MCTA Hqrs take initiatives with the MZU authorities 'to allow the College professors who are qualified to become research guide' by amending the existing MZU ordinance. (Govt. Mamit College)**

The Chairman informed the meeting that this may not be possible as the MZU itself did not permitted its own constituent college to conduct research guidance.

10. Condolence programme be organized during the annual conferences Member(s) who passed away (demise) between Conferences.

The Chairman informed the meeting that this is the present practice of the Hqrs.

11. Let the MCTA Hqrs open a saving bank account in SBI in the name of Finance Secretary or Treasurer. (Lunglei Govt. College)

The Chairman informed the meeting that a Saving Bank Account was opened at the SBI, Dawrpui Branch in the name of President and Treasurer, MCTA Hqrs.
