Mr. Thanglura presided over the Annual General Conference Business Session. The Chairman invited Dr. P.L. Ramliana, General Secretary, to give Annual Report of MCTA during the year 2012-2013. After offering greetings to the members of MCTA, a brief introduction of Executive Body follows. The General Secretary presented the Annual Report of MCTA during the year 2012-2013. The Chairman invited Mr. H. Lalnunmawia, Treasurer to give Financial Report for the year 2012-2013.

After clarification the Conference adopts and approves the Annual Report of the General Secretary and Financial Report of the Treasurer.

Deliberation of Agenda follows.

1. ***“Let the Mizoram University decide who is to bear the TA/DA of Experts for Screening Committee/Selection Committee (Govt. Aizawl West College).”***

The Chairman invited representative from Govt. Aizawl West College to move the agenda. After discussion it is resolved that MCTA Hqrs. take necessary action to decide who is to bear the TA/DA/Sitting Allowances of Experts for Screening Committee/Selection Committee. It also resolved that the said expenditure should not be borne by individuals.

2. ***The MCTA General Conference be held biennially/ after every one year, that is, only in the year of Headquarters Office Bearers Election (Govt. Aizawl North College).***

The Chairman invited representative from the College to move the agenda. After a brief discussion the Conference resolves that the Conference be held annually as practiced presently.

3. ***The Govt. of Mizoram be moved to depute a suitable candidate from the teaching faculty of Govt. colleges in Mizoram to the post of Deputy Secretary in Higher and technical Education Department, Govt. of Mizoram (Govt. Champhai College).***

The Chairman requested delegate from Govt. Champhai College to move the agenda. After careful deliberation the Conference entrusted the MCTA Headquarters to pursue the matter inclusive of other related matter already taken up by the MCTA Headquarters.

4. ***The Govt. of Mizoram be pressurised to implement superannuation age as per UGC Regulations (Govt. T. Romana College).***

After the matter is moved by the concerned college, the Conference resolves to pass the agenda as it is after thorough deliberation.

5. ***Let the MCTA Headquarters take necessary actions for early payment of Medical Reimbursement (MR) Bills (Govt. T. Romana College).***

The Chairman requested delegate from the concerned College to move the agenda. The Conference carefully considered the matter and resolves that MCTA Headquarters should continue to take necessary actions for early payment of Medical Reimbursement (MR) Bills.

6. ***MZU Authority be pressurised to allow college teachers to guide/supervise M.Phil/Ph.D students (Govt. Zirtiri Residential Science College/Govt. Johnson College).***

On invitation from the Chairman, representative from the concerned colleges introduced the agenda. As this matter is currently taken up by the Headquarters without success the matter be pursued by MCTA Headquarters.

7. ***As Semester system has been introduced and as the University norms and the UGC indicate teacher-student ratio, let the MCTA Headquarters take necessary action to stop outside interference to admit students in excess of the normative capacities in colleges (Govt. Hrangbana College).***

The Chairman invited delegate from the concerned college to move the agenda. The Conference resolves to pass the agenda as it is.

8. ***Regarding Draft Rules on 'Mizoram Higher Education Service Rules 2013' on recruitment of Assistant Director: "Vacancies in the Grade shall be filled up by 100% direct recruitment" be substituted by "100% posts shall be filled up from the existing Assistant Professor" (Govt. Aizawl College).***

On invitation of the Chairman, representative of the concerned college move the agenda. After careful deliberation the Conference resolves to adopt the agenda as it is.

9. ***Amendment of the Constitution: Article IX. Clause 1 "Ten or more Lecturers (including Principal) in a college or college level training Institution may constitute an MCTA Branch with the approval of the MCTA Headquarters on application from such Institution" be replaced by***

"Five or more teachers (including Principal) in a college or college level training Institution may constitute an MCTA Branch with the approval of the MCTA Headquarters on application from such institution" (MCTA Headquarters).

The Chairman invited the General Secretary to move the amendment bill. The Conference amended the Constitution as proposed by more than 2/3 majority.

10. ***Let the MCTA Headquarters take steps for the development of infrastructure in Higher Education through proper implementation of RUSA (MCTA Headquarters).***

The General Secretary of MCTA Headquarters moves the agenda on invitation from the Chairman. The Chairman also requested Dr. K.L. Pradhan, Joint Director, Higher

& Technical Education to introduce RUSA. The Conference resolves that MCTA Headquarters take steps for proper implementation of RUSA.

- 11. Amendment of the Constitution: Article V. clause 1** *“Any person working in Government colleges or college level training Institutions of Mizoram under the University Grants Commission (UGC) norms as Lecturers/ Reader/ Professor/ Principal may become a member of MCTA be replaced by*
“Any person working in Government colleges or college level training Institutions of Mizoram under the University Grants Commission (UGC) norms as Assistant Professor/ Associate Professor/ Professor/ Principal may become a member of the MCTA (MCTA Headquarters).

The Chairman invited the General Secretary to move the amendment bill. The Conference unanimously agrees to amend the Constitution regarding nomenclature change as result of the adoption of UGC Regulation 2010.

GROUP B

1. Let the Environmental Studies question pattern be revised (Govt. Aizawl West College).
2. The Mizoram University be moved to terminate/ abolish the objective papers for the 5th and 6th semester Core UG Examination (Govt. Aizawl North College).
3. The Govt. of Mizoram be requested to create a post for Environmental Studies teacher in the colleges (Govt.T.Romana College)
4. Let the MCTA Headquarters move the MZU Authority to amend MZU regulation for introducing only descriptive type of questions in the 5th and 6th semester from 2014 (Govt.Hrangbana College).

The Chairman clarifies the matters regarding the issues in Group B.
