MINUTES OF BUSINESS SESSION (12:30 p.m - 3:30 p.m)

The business session was presided over by Pu Thanglura, President, MCTA Hqrs. The Chairman invited the members to actively participate in the business transaction.

General Secretary's Report:

On the invitation of the Chairman, Dr. P.L. Ramliana, General Secretary gave a detailed report of the activities of the MCTA Hqrs during the year 2014-2015. According to the statistical report given by the General Secretary, there are **193** Asst. Professors, **424** Associate Professors and **11** Professors in the community of the MCTA. The number of vacant posts as reported by member branches is 127 and 11 teachers retired during the year 2015. The general secretary's report prepared in booklet was distributed to the delegates.

The Chairman requested members to raise queries on the General Secretary's report. After making clarification for a number of queries raised by the delegates, the report was approved by the floor. The Chairman then requested Pu H.Lalnunmawia, Treasurer, to place the Statement of Account, 2014-2015 before the meeting.

Finance Report :

Pu H.Lalnunmawia, Treasurer, MCTA Hqrs placed audited statement of accounts for the year 2014-2015 before the meeting. As per the report, the statement of account was given as follows:

After making necessary clarification for a number of queries raised by the delegates, the floor approved the report. The floor further requested all the branches to submit fees and funds on time.

The Chairman then opened the floor for discussion. After active deliberations on the proposed agenda, the meeting arrived at the following resolutions:

AGENDA & RESOLUTIONS

(GROUP A)

- 1. The MZU be pressurized not to implement Choice Based Credit System until and unless properly learned about the introduction of CBCS in other states. (Govt. Aizawl College)**

*The Chairman invited the concerned Branch to move the agenda. After the agenda was moved, it was discussed and finally resolved that **the MZU be pressurized not to implement Choice Based Credit System until and unless properly learned about the introduction of CBCS in other states.***

- 2. Let the MCTA take necessary steps to establish PG Departments in colleges as per NAAC Peer team recommendations. (Govt. Hrangbana College & Govt. Aizawl West College)**

*The Chairman invited one of the submitting Branches, Govt Aizawl West College to move the agenda. After the agenda was moved, it was discussed and resolved that **necessary steps should be taken to establish PG Departments in colleges as per NAAC Peer team recommendations.***

- 3. The Government of Mizoram be moved to fill up vacant posts in various colleges arising out of superannuation/ voluntary retirement. (GZRSC)**

*The Chairman asked the concerned college to move the agenda. After deliberations and clarifications made by the concerned member Branch, the meeting resolved that **the MCTA Headquarters Executive Committee must pressurize the State Government to fill up all vacant posts of Asst. Professors in all the Colleges.***

- 4. The Government of Mizoram be moved to provide sufficient teachers as per the UGC Regulations by means of fresh recruitment (Govt. Champhai College & Hqrs).**

The Chairman invited the concerned Branch to move the agenda. After discussion it was resolved that the Govt of Mizoram be moved to provide sufficient teachers as per UGC Regulations by means of fresh recruitment.

5. The Government of Mizoram be requested to maintain at least the minimum strength of faculty in each department of the colleges. (Govt.Khawzawl College).

In absence of the submitting branch, the Chairman clarified the agenda and the floor resolved as it was proposed in the agenda.

(Group B)
(On-going Activities & Clarification)

1. The government of Mizoram be requested to place those contract faculty members in the same college when regularized by the government. (Govt. Saiha College)

The Chairman informed the meeting that in view of the rules followed by the Government, the agenda was not opened for discussion.

2. The Government of Mizoram be moved to implement UGC Regulations 2010 in toto. (Govt. Champhai College)

The Chairman informed the meeting that realization of the matter is very difficult in view of the present situation.

3. Let the Government of Mizoram be moved to convert the existing qualified part-time Assistant Professors into contractual Assistant Professors. (Govt.Serchhip College & Govt. Khawzawl College)

The Chairman explained that as per the UGC Rules, the matter may not be feasible.

4. The existing rate of remuneration for paper evaluation and question setting in MZU may be enhanced. (GZRSC)

The Chairman informed the meeting that the matter is an on-going activity of the Hqrs.

5. MCTA members may be pressurised to have greater involvement in evaluating Undergraduate (UG) examination papers. (Govt. Aizawl College)

The Chairman notified the meeting that the matter is an ongoing activity of the MCTA.

6. The Government of Mizoram be pressurised not to extend the service of Guest faculty without Performance Certificate from the concerned College Authority. (Govt. Aizawl College)

The Chairman apprised that the matter is already brought to the notice of the authority.
