

MINUTES OF THE MIZORAM COLLEGE TEACHER'S ASSOCIATION 38TH ANNUAL GENERAL CONFERENCE, 2016

DATE: 3rd NOVEMBER, 2016
PLACE: CYMA'S CONFERENCE HALL, TUIKHUAHTLANG, AIZAWL
TIME: 1.00 PM

The second session was chaired by the President, MCTA, Dr. P.L Ramliana. After welcoming the members, he invited members from different colleges to stand from their seats to endorse their presence.

After a solo performance by Lallawmzuali Khiangte, the Treasure CVL Tlanhlua gave a Finance Report, details of which is given in the Conference booklet. Out of the General Fund Account, total receipts is Rs. 594,401/- and total expenditure is Rs. 513,715/-. Closing balance as on 12th October, 2016 is Rs.80,686/-. Out of the Condolence Fund Account, total receipts is Rs. 386.427/-, expenditure is Rs. 300.000/- . Closing balance as on 12th October 2016 is Rs.86.427/-

Then a solo performance was invited again by the Chairman, given by Lalhlumawii. The Chairman then invited the floor to give queries/clarifications/feedback from the General Secretary's Report and also from the Finance Reports given in the Conference Booklet. The following clarifications were made:

1. On the query regarding the number of posts available as highlighted in page 9 of the Conference Booklet, the General Secretary clarified that he may have made a mistake in collecting data from the colleges.

2. The Treasurer also clarified that the nine colleges reflected in serial no.2 of his Finance Report are colleges that were not entered in the previous year's statement and that the present year accounts for membership is not yet reflected in the statement because the auditing was done before receiving the funds from all the colleges.

Then the Conference went on to deliberate on the agenda at hand.

AGENDA

Group A:

1. Govt of Mizoram be strongly pressurized to fill up teachers' sanctioned post which are lying vacant at various Colleges in Mizoram.
(Govt. Aizawl College/Govt. Hrangbana College/ Govt. Serchhip College/ Govt. Aizawl West College)

Resolution: After a detailed deliberation from various members who expressed the importance of the agenda, it was resolved that the agenda should be strongly pursued by the MCTA Headquarters.

2. The State Government be urged to meet the need for teacher in Environmental Studies (Foundation Course) in IV Semester (Govt. T.Romana College).

Resolution: The conference resolved that the agenda is not accepted as proposed as majority members present, by a show of hand are not in favour of it. Colleges can continue as before and the Principals of each college will assign teacher to take the subject.

3. Let Mizoram University be moved to change the pattern of Central evaluation process in evaluating the university answer scripts, and may be distributed to different Colleges in Mizoram with proper monitoring (Govt. Champhai College).

Resolution: The conference resolved that the agenda is not accepted as proposed as majority members present, by a show of hand are not in favour of it.

4. Deserving Professors from colleges should be considered as full Ph.D guides and not as co-guides (Govt. Aizawl College/Govt. Johnson College).

Resolution: The Conference resolved that the agenda be accepted but changes be made in the wordings that 'the Mizoram University should allow eligible teachers from Under-graduate colleges in Mizoram to act as full Ph.D guides'.

5. Title registration with ISSN be applied for MCTA Newsletter and be published in a book-let form from the next issue (Govt. J.Thankima College).

Resolution: The Conference accepted the agenda as proposed by a majority show of hands. Necessary steps may be taken towards its fulfilment in due time by MCTA Headquarters.

6. MCTA may take up steps to bring better coordination between MZU and State Government in the Department of Higher & Technical Education. (Govt. Aizawl College)

Resolution: The Conference accepted the agenda proposed and necessary steps will be taken by the MCTA Headquarters towards its fulfilment.

7. MZU authority be pressurized to consider opening of P.G. classes in affiliating undergraduate Colleges. (Govt. Aizawl College)

Resolution: As steps had already been taken by the MCTA Headquarters in this regard, the agenda need not be passed.

8. A proposal for necessary revisions and amendments of the MCTA Constitution. (MCTA (Hqrs) Executive Committee)

Resolution: The revisions and amendments of the MCTA Constitution proposed by the MCTA Headquarters is accepted by absolute majority of the members present.

9. The MCTA 39th Annual General Conference 2017 may be held at the Govt. Champhai College. (Govt. Champhai College)

Resolution: The invitation to host the MCTA 39th Annual General Conference 2017 by Govt. Champhai College is accepted with pleasure.

Group B:

1. Steps be taken by MCTA Hqrs to hasten the proposal which has been underway for mass conversion of qualified part-time Assistant Professors into Contractual Assistant Professors.(Govt. Serchhip College).
2. Offer of appointments for Officers (like Director, Joint Director etc.) in the Directorate of Higher and Technical Education Office be made as per seniority of Government College Teachers.(Govt. Lunglei College)
3. The Govt. Of Mizoram be advised to create the post of Librarians in the colleges where they are non-existent for overall progress of the institution (Govt. Johnson College).
4. Let the MCTA strongly move the Government that no transfer should take place for the Contract/Part Time College Teachers as their appointments were done on need base of the particular institutions (Based on Office Memorandum, Higher and Technical Education, Govt. of Mizoram No. A.22018/5/2013-THE/13) (Govt. Mamit College)
5. Preparation of ID card for all Members (Govt. J.Buana College).
6. MCTA to make Plans/recommendations on implementing of the 7th pay. (Govt. Aizawl College).

The agenda in group B is not open for general discussions. The Chairman made necessary explanations and clarifications on each point which were unanimously accepted by the Conference.
